

# Show Choir Band Auditions

Instruments should prepare the following and submit on [THIS FORM](#) by Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup> at 11:59pm:

## Trumpet/Trombone/Sax

1. One etude or audition piece that shows off skills. Choose a section with a max of 2 minutes. (Jazz band etude works)
2. Perform your instrument's excerpt from [THIS FOLDER](#) at the given tempo.

## Other Wind Instruments/Orchestral Strings

1. One etude or audition piece that shows off skills. Choose a section with a max of 2 minutes. (Jazz band etude works)

## Aux Percussion

1. Prepare [this rhythm](#) given on one non-pitched percussion instrument.

## Drum Set

1. Video 1:
  - a. Play a 30 second swing pattern at Quarter=128 with fills
  - b. Play a 30 second rock pattern at Quarter=145 with fills
  - c. Play a 30 second funk pattern at Quarter=100 with fills (First 3 patterns should all be recorded in succession on the same video)
2. Video 2:
  - a. Play a drum pattern that goes with the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Song "Wolves." Please play from 2:17 to the end of the song. Feel free to expand from what is in the original while maintaining the style and rhythmic integrity. [HERE IS THE LINK](#)
  - b. You can do this with or without the song playing in the background.

## Guitar (Acoustic and Electric), and Bass Guitar-

1. Play a solo that shows off your technique and skill. Acoustic/Electric would ideally include a portion of strumming and a portion of picking.
2. Play a short section of a song that uses standard notation (not tabs.) Please show the piece of music to the camera.

## Piano/Synth

1. Play 30 seconds to one minute of a technically advanced piece.
2. Play [THIS EXCERPT](#) from this year's 10th Street Edition show from measure 1-25.
